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CONTENT DECLARATION concerning to:

Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European parliament and of the council of 19 December 2024 on packaging and packaging waste, amending Regulation (EU) 2019/1020 and Directive (EU) 2019/904, and repealing Directive 94/62/EC

Product:

Materials used for the packaging of products supplied by Nitto Belgium NV

The packaging of products that are manufactured by Nitto Belgium NV is conform to the requirements for substances in packaging. The total incidental concentration level of lead, mercury, cadmium, and hexavalent chromium is not above 100 ppm.

According to our current best knowledge PFAS and SVHC are not contained in our packaging materials.

Plastic, paper and wooden packaging material can be recycled.

At the date of issue of this declaration the use of an established identification system for packaging materials under Commission Decision 97/129/EC is not mandatory, the use of the numbering and abbreviations of the identification system is voluntary.

From 12 August 2028 certain packaging shall be marked with a harmonised label. Nitto Belgium NV will take appropriate measures to comply with the harmonised labelling requirements.
